## WTC Utah Observations

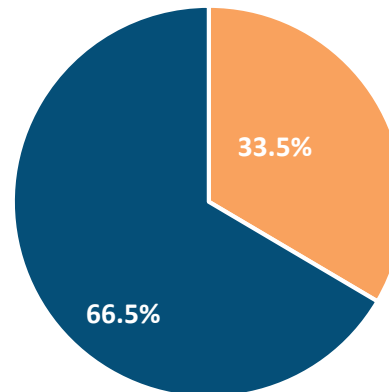
Utah exports to the United Kingdom dropped by \$299 Million compared to the previous month, the drop in the value of metals exported being the primary reason for this.

Other markets, such as Canada, Mexico and China, have experienced less volatility in terms of exports. These countries also do not receive as many metal exports as the United Kingdom.

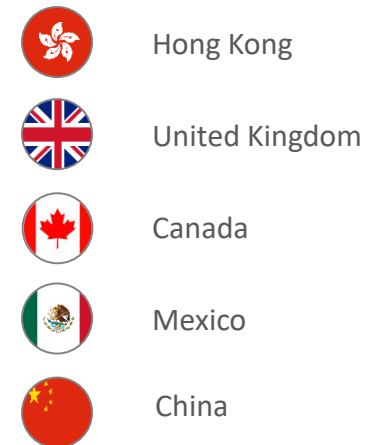

■ Metals (NAICS 212 & 331) ■ Value Added

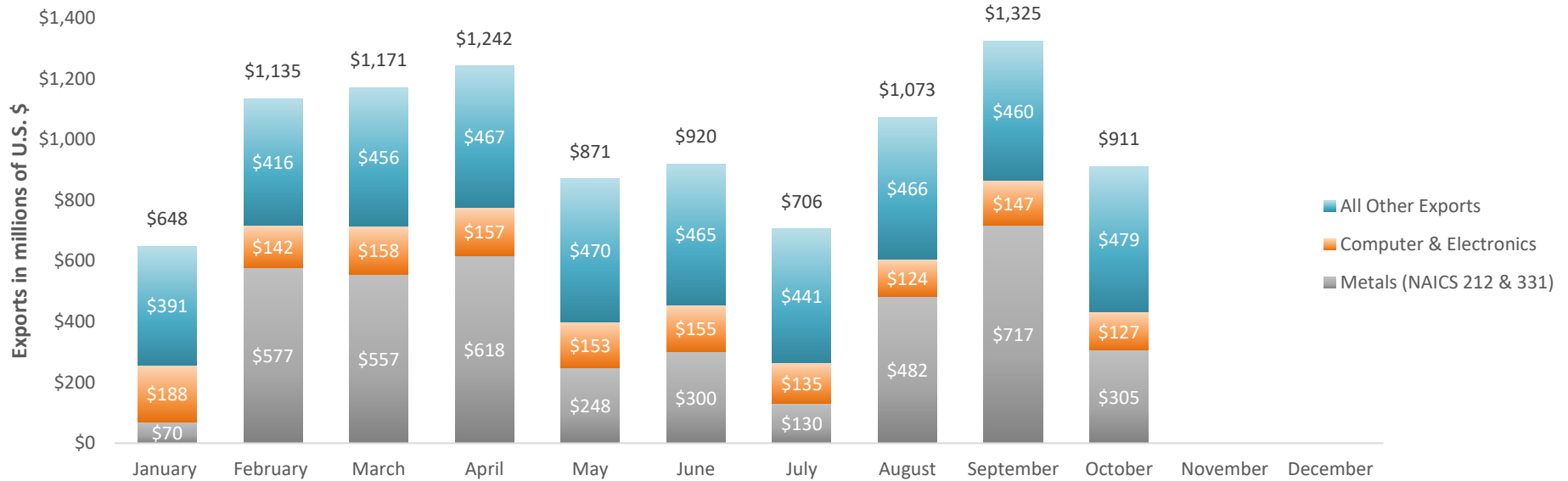

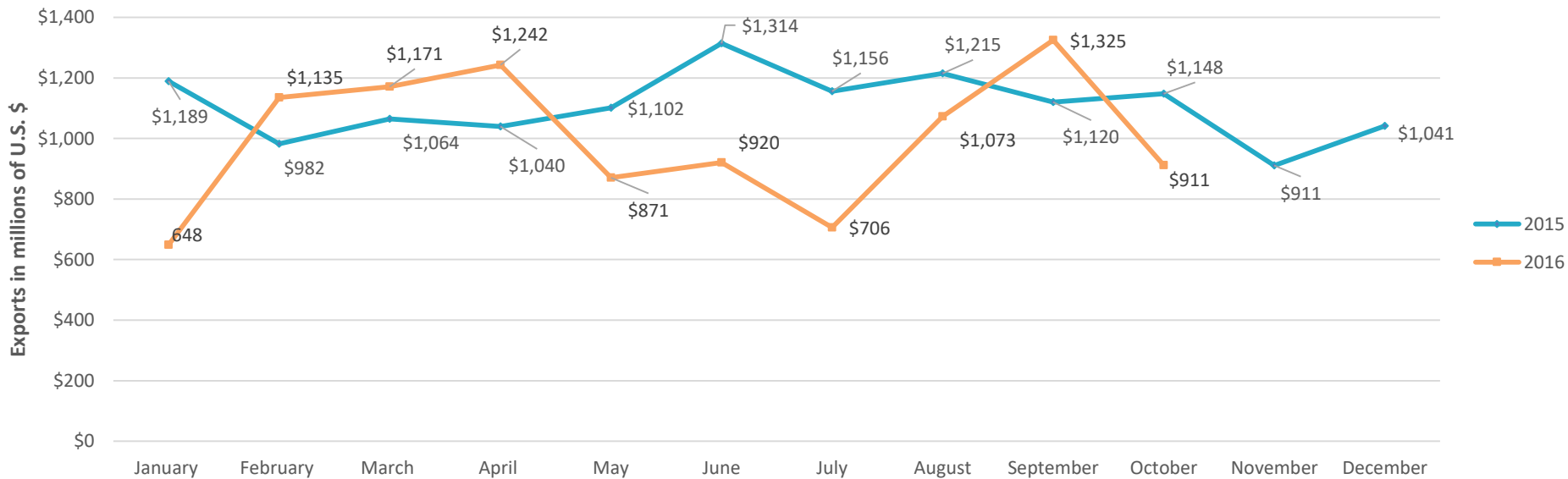

# Utah Exports (Metals, Computer & Electronics, All Other Exports) 2016

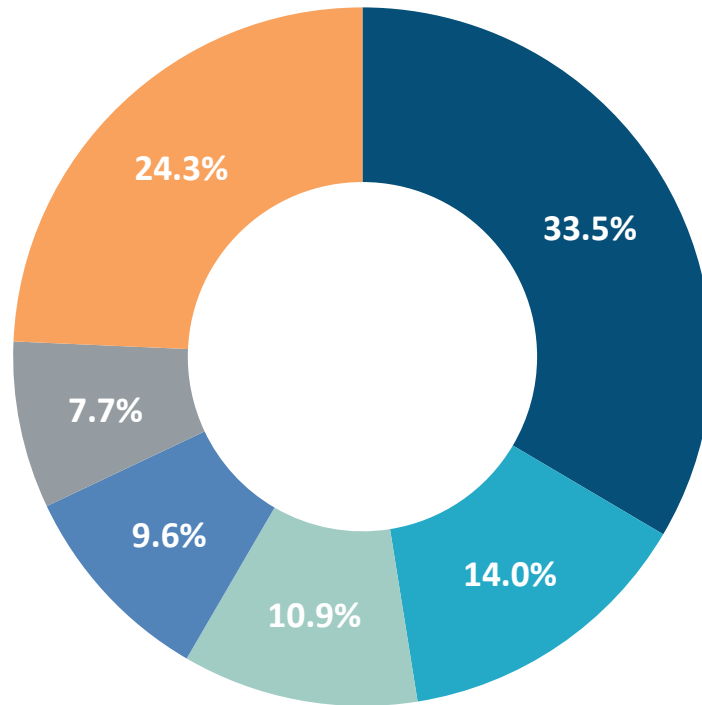


## 2015 & 2016 Exports by Month

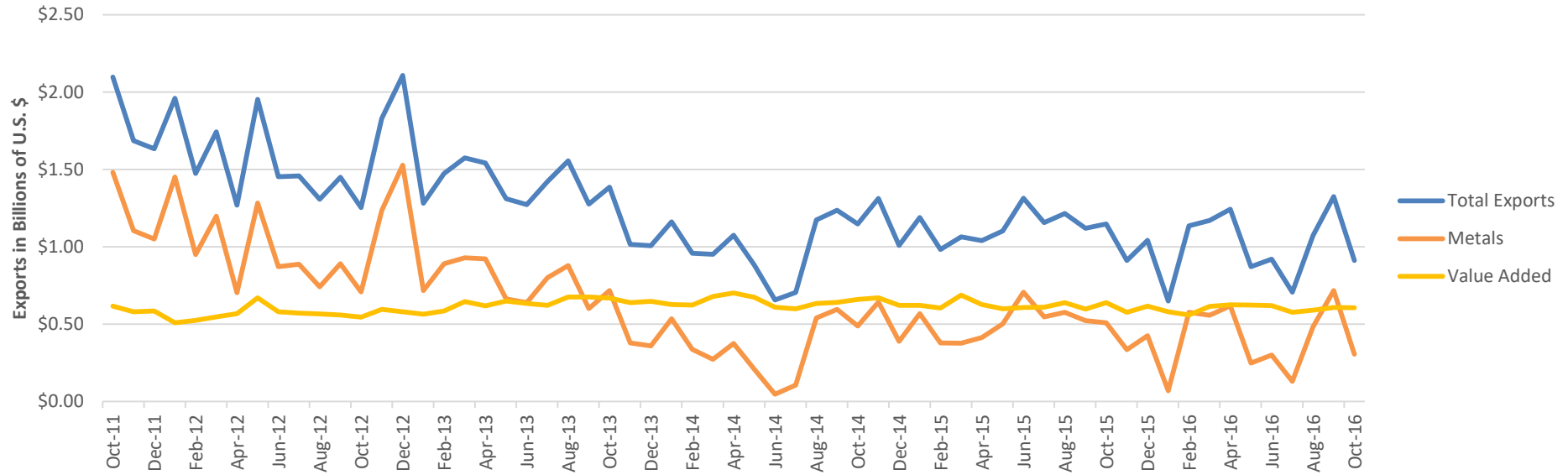

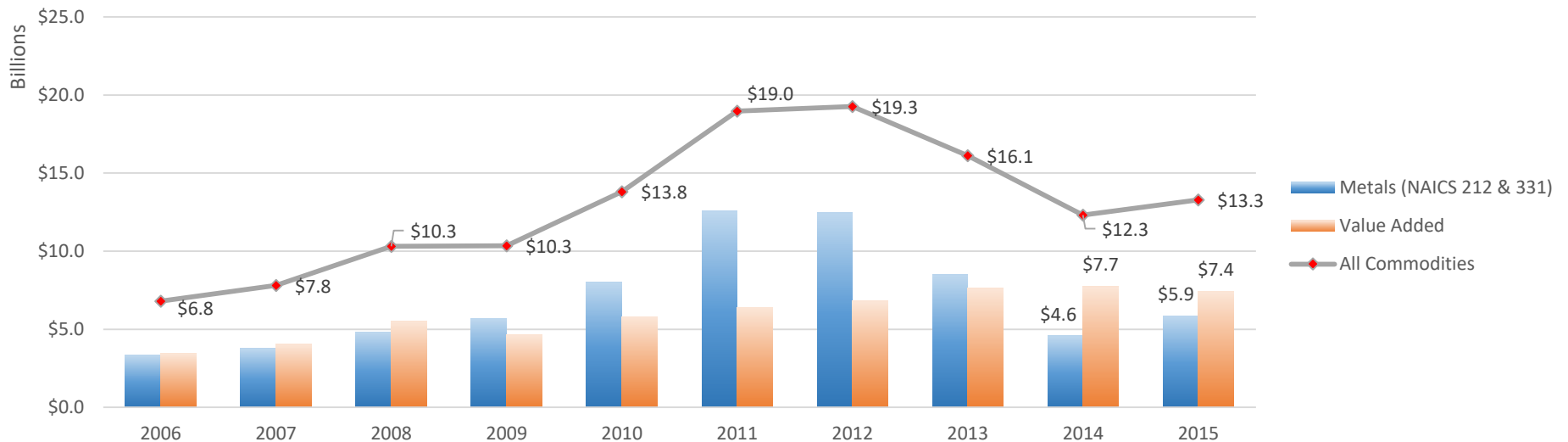

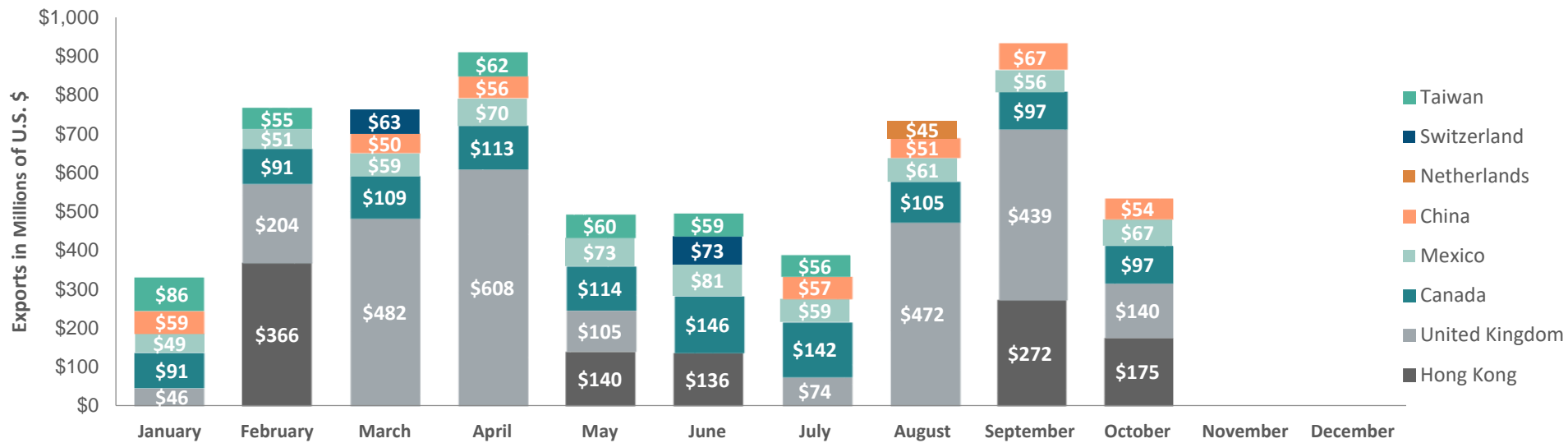
## 5-Year Rolling Total Export Overview by Month
